DAY 01 28 Apr 13 Upington - Cammspannen Private Reserve and 4x4 Trails Arrive at Upington Airport at 11:00 from Cape Town. Depart to Cammspannen Private Reserve. Cammspannen is a privately owned Nature Reserve, uninhabited and management of the Reserve has been taken over by Dantes Liebenberg. Cammspannen is situated in the Mier area in the most remote part of South Africa, 320 km from Upington via Twee Rivieren on the R360. Cammspannen covers 12 800 ha of typical Kalahari duneveld in the Arid Savannah biome of South Africa. Its northern border is 500m south of the Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park's southern border and in the west it borders on Namibia.

Gemsbok, red hartebeest, blue wildebeest, springbok, duiker, steenbok and ostrich are residents. The main carnivores are leopard, brown hyena, caracal, black-backed jackal and African wild cat. Kori Bustard, secretary birds, martial -, black breasted snake - and tawny eagles and southern pale chanting goshawks are common sightings.

Do a night game drive with the possibility to see nocturnal animals including aardvark, porcupine, aardwolf, springhare, leopard, Cape fox, bat-eared fox, African wild cat, small spotted genet and striped pole-cat.

Overnight: Camping at Cammspannen Tent Camp Meals: B & D

DAY 02 29 Apr 13 Cammspannen – Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park

Do a morning game – and scenic drive on a 4x4 trail. Depart to **Twee Rivieren Camp** in **Kgalagadi Trans Frontier Park**. Continue on an afternoon game drive in the southern section in this 37 000 square km park, which is one of the largest conservation areas in the world and one of the last truly unspoilt ecosystems.

Endemic game such as gemsbok, springbok, eland, giraffe, blue wildebeest and red hartebeest roam the sparsely vegetated red sand dunes and the dry river valleys of the Nossob and Auob where a variety of acacia species thrive.

The Park is well known for good sightings of lion, leopard and cheetah and spotted - and brown hyena are common residents. Because of an abundance of prey in the form of mice, whistling rats, birds and insects, smaller predators thrive in the park. The park is home to caracal, honey badger, black-backed jackal, bat-eared fox, cape fox, African wildcat, mongoose and the ever-popular suricate (meerkat).

Kgalagadi is a bird watcher's paradise with more than 300 species recorded including at least 20 larger raptor species. The world's heaviest flying bird, the Kori bustard and the stately secretary bird patrol the riverbeds while the noisy northern black korhaan rule in the dunes.

The Twee Rivieren area is known for lion, leopard, cheetah and meerkat sightings.

Exit the park late afternoon and proceed to Kgalagadi Lodge 06 km outside the park.Overnight:Kgalagadi Lodge camping (Excellent ablution facilities)Meals:B & D

DAY 03 30 Apr 13 Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park

Enter the park. Morning and afternoon game drives in Kgalagadi Park **Overnight:** Kgalagadi Lodge camping Meals: B & D

DAY 04 01 May 13 Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park

Enter the park. Depart on a game drive to Nossob Camp. Do an afternoon game drive. The Nossob area is known for lion activities

Overnight: Nossob camping (Good ablution facilities) Meals: B & D

DAY 05 02 May 13 Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park

Morning and afternoon game drives in the Nossob area. **Overnight:** Nossob camping Meals: B & D

DAY 06 03 May 13 Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park - Upington

Game drive to Twee Rivieren until 13:00. Depart back to Upington. En route we stop at the last indigenous **San tribe** in South Africa, the Khomani. Today these earliest residents of the Kalahari, living here for 40 000 years, consist of only 400 people and are resident in an area between 40 and 70 km south of Twee Rivieren. Clients will have the opportunity to view and purchase their handcraft at one of the roadside stalls. Continue to Upington.. **Overnight:** Single room at Mazurka Waters B&B*** or De Duine B&B***

Meals: B (Dinner at own cost in nearby restaurant)

DAY 07 04 May 13 Departure

Transfer to Upington Airport at 10:00 for departing flight at 11:30

It is expected from clients to assist with pitching and packing camp
